**Athletic Director Report**

I. Winter Sport Review-

- A. **Basketball (Boys)**- V 12, JV 12, F 13, KLAA 12-2, KLAA West and KLAA Conference champions, most wins since 2009-2010, Led by a strong senior class, our team had an outstanding season. We played as a team and represented the school well. The lower level teams also had a successful years, showing that the future is bright!
- B. **Basketball (Girls)**- V 11, JV 10, F 10/Beat John Glenn and had 10/11 players score in that game. Beat WLW to advance to the district semi-final game against Northville. This season wasn't about wins and losses. It was about growth. We had a rebuild at the varsity level and had success at the sub varsity levels. Our varsity team never gave up, even when the scoreboard didn't reflect their efforts. Our players learned a lot and every single one improved as the season progressed.
- C. **Bowling (Boys & Girls)**- V 18, JV 2/Maddy Gazzarari Singles Division 1 State Champion/We are slowly building up a core of bowlers, But recruiting still is lagging behind
- D. **Cheerleading (Competitive)**- V 22, We placed 5th at both KLAA West Meets & 1st place in the Silver KLAA Crossover Bracket. This year we beat our Round 3 high score record and our Overall Total score records (Score Records I have access to date back over the past 6 years from 2019-2020). This season provided many of our student athletes to step into leadership roles and try various stunt positions. As our program continues to grow in number of athletes both at the HS & MS level our skills (difficulty & execution) also continue to improve. We are excited to continue our Junior Wildcat Competitive Cheer Program for our 5th & 6th graders to gain more interest in competitive cheer.
- E. **Figure Skating**- V & JV 15/We had 15 skaters on the team. 10 skaters earned their Varsity Letter. 5 Skaters earned a certificate of participation. Our A Team Placed 3rd Overall. C Team Placed 6th Overall in our district. Our A Team skated amazing and placed 1st in many categories (Jumps, Spins and Skating Elements) during the season. They were a great representation of Novi High School as Elite Athletes in Figure Skating. In the High School STATES Individual Competition, our skaters did exceptionally well. 5 State Champions (placed top 3 in final rounds) and 5 initial round medalist (placed top 3). Novi High School Placed 3rd OVERALL in the Michigan High School States Individual Competition-out of 36 High School Teams. This is impressive! We had a successful year in our placements at competitions. This is a direct result of hard work and dedication to the sport. As coaches we are most proud of the skaters for who they are as individuals. This is one of the best group of girls we've had the honor to coach. They are kind and truly supportive and help each other. Looking forward to next season as we have some great skaters coming in from the 8th grade.
- F. **Gymnastics**- V 12, KLAA 3-4/Our team had a season of growth and improvement. We welcomed 5 new members, and of our 12 member team 11 qualified to regionals individually on at least one event. We had 2 state individual qualifiers: Kira Kozlowski and Alexa Vance. Alexa placed 10th on Division 2 vault, and Kira placed 9th on Division 1 floor. We had a very successful season both as a team and for each member individually.

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Our team scores increased throughout the season as we became more consistent in our performances, and this was also reflected in the athletes qualifying for regionals and states. We look forward to having even more success next season as we continue to work hard in the off season and prepare to be more competitive in the KLAA Conference.

- G. **Hockey- V 18, KLAA 5-5/** Was a great first season coaching this program. With the support of my family, Athletic Admin staff, and the families on our team that helped make this a great year, I feel we made it the best year we could for our varsity athletes. We had some big wins and some losses that hurt more than others but everyday was a joy to be at the rink and I am looking forward to next season. We're in the off-season now and as we begin to plan things out it brings much excitement with the prospects we have and returners we expect to welcome back. We'll be younger than we were this season but we have a lot of experience and some high end talent coming in. The beauty of it all and the roller coaster of varsity sports is that a lot of KLAA teams were senior heavy this season, so we look forward to making some noise next season with our young core.
- H. **Pom- V 15, 2nd place High Kick, 4th place Class A D1 States,** Our team had a wonderful season this year! They were able to achieve their goal of placing top 5 in both competitions this year and all of our athletes on Varsity are KLAA Scholar Athletes!
- I. **Ski (Boys & Girls)- V B 9, JV B 5, V G 9, JV G 6, 4th overall KLAA Conference, 2 all division athletes, 1 MHSAA all region, 4 All Conference athletes, Best weather we have had in a long time!** Girls had a great season. Team was close to qualifying for states. Boys is a rebuilding year with only 3 upperclassmen but the future is bright. Camber Smith qualified for States and took 32 overall in Giant Slalom.
- J. **Snowboard Cross (Boys & Girls)- V 7, JV 3/ Varsity Girls team made it to State Finals for first time. Varsity Boys team made it to Last Chance Qualifier for first time. Both Boys and Girls individual riders made it to Quarter finals for first time. Varsity 1 Boy (Joey Saeli) was #1 seed and set fastest time at State finals.**
- K. **Swim & Dive (Boys)- V 30, JV 35/ KLAA 5-2, 2nd place KLAA, 7th Oakland county, 1st and 5th and 14th at diving regional, 22 seniors ending their swim and dive careers on a well swim 2nd place finish at KLAA championship showed their leadership and commitment to their final season. They are leaving a positive legacy for rest of team. It's been a very fun and challenging year. Big time time and technique improvements were had by all.**
- L. **Wrestling (Boys & Girls)- 14 V, 20 JV, 5 Girls, KLAA 4-4, 2 men KLAA placers, first ever KLAA woman's champ, 3 regional qualifiers, 1 state qualifier, 1 state placer, 4th place finisher ( 1st qualifier since 2021, first placer since 2011, highest placement since 2008)/We only lost around 5 kids all season. Retention is high. We have 36 returning next year and 29 returning in 2 years. A lot of family participation, great staff and future looks bright. KLAA placers, best Northville (first time in 5 years), state placer.**
- M. **Unified Basketball- 50 participants/**This is from a student: *This year was my first year playing Unified Basketball at Novi High school. During the first few practices, I had a mix of nervousness and uncertainty, but now, words can't fully describe how much fun I've had playing Unified Basketball. Every practice and game has made me enjoy it more and more. Playing Unified made me realize how most people take playing sports for granted, but our athletes give it their all at every practice and game with so much passion. I have made so many great, true friendships in just the few months I*
