Minutes for August 14, 2013

Attendance: There were 35 people in attendance and 27 Teams were represented. See attendance Sheet for complete list.

President Ray Notarantonio called meeting to order at 6:35 p.m.

- **Secretary's Report:** Noreen Serra
Minutes from the June meeting were presented for approval. Motion to approve minutes made by Mark Tobias and Second by Butch Wingfield. Motion passed.
- **Treasurer's Report:** Marcy Salemi
Marcy mentioned purchase of \$50,000 of the \$100,000 already earmarked for weight room equipment. Due to the transition from John Lesko and Marcy Salemi the report was unavailable to present at this meeting and will be presented at the September meeting.

Committee Reports:

- **Athletic Director's Report:** Brian Gordon
 - Weight Room equipment-most is in place and the old equipment has been moved to Highland Park High School. Thanks to Jim Kielboso and his staff for moving out old and in new equipment and raising almost \$2,000 with a fundraiser boot camp to pay Novi Athletic department for the donated equipment to Highland Park H.S.
 - Athletic registration is complete at the high school. Over 550 athletes were registered.
 - Summer camps at the high school had over 300 participants.
 - Concussion testing for all athletes is underway through the guidance of our new trainer Chase Kreger.
 - Annual Coaches Retreat was reinstated with over 45 coaches from the high school and middle school participating. Featured guest was Athletic Director Todd Patulski from Baylor University.
 - Coaches participated in the Summer Coaches Clinics Series at Walled Lake Schools. Featured speakers were Lloyd Carr, Dan Enos (CMU), among many others.
 - 2013 Fall Athletic Team Requests Motion to approve this Fall request of \$18,046.50 with the stipulation that the two teams of Pom and Boys Cross Country need to 'Opt-in" to a leadership position of the 41 open positions available. Motion seconded by Butch...motion approved. ***(After meeting ended, both teams had a representative and took on leadership roles to Opt-in. So full amount of \$18,046.50 will be paid by boosters with receipts in return)***
 - KLAA Media Day held for football was a success with all 24 schools here at Novi on August 8th with Qdoba as a food sponsor.
 - New sound system in the weight room has been installed.

- Invisible Fence is a NEW sponsor on the Score Board.
- **Tastefest Update:** Butch Wingfield
 - Noreen Serra will be coordinating the volunteers needed for this event and wrestling boys have agreed to help with the heavy lifting at set-up and tear-down.
