President's Report – Chuck Wright

- By-Laws
 - Discussion around term limitations for Board members. Currently states 2 years.
 Change suggested to remove term limit.
 - Update needed to change when the new board becomes effective. Change suggested to note that the new Board takes office in August.
 - Vote on the above changes will occur at the September meeting.

Committee Reports:

A. AD's Report - Brian Gordon

- Football started 8/7 and all other sports started 8/9. Rosters scheduled to be finalized 8/11.
- Parent meeting schedule for August 21st at 6:00 p.m. Core Institute will talk about concussions and Will Heininger will be the speaker
- A little over 500 signed up for fall sports with a lot of middle school students
- August 17th is picture day except for Football as they have a scrimmage on this day
- Live stream cameras will be in use in the performance gym and the stadium which will allow for live streaming of sporting events on the internet. Cameras should be up and running by September 1st. Cost for 2 cameras is \$9,000. The district receives a portion of the subscription costs which is paid by those wanting to view the live stream events. Brian gave a demonstration of the live stream to the group.

- **B.** NCSD Golf Outing Tom O'Connor Sponsorship is up and community participation is done. Host sponsors are sold out with Denso as the event sponsor. If numbers stay the same the



payout would be approx. \$2,000 which is half of what we received last year. More participation needed from athletic teams.

- **C. Sports Pass Karen Krawrec -** Volunteers needed for High School Registration. The Board will be using the app State Champs for containing your sports pass within your smartphone as a pilot. Cost for sports pass is \$60 for students and \$180 for family.
- **D.** Concessions Lisa Rice Everything is covered except middle school football. We now have a pretzel machine that will be used this year.
- E. Sports Program Mark Tobias Should be out by Tastefest. Good Luck ads are \$50
- **F.** Craft Show Sheri VanKirk \$11,000 raised since January from crafters and booth rentals. Additional funds will come from entrance fee and concessions on the day of the event. No sponsorships yet. 183 spots available, 145 filled. Event is October 21st from 9:30 4:00, \$3.00 entrance fee.
- **G.** Tastefest Jeff Wasser 75% of restaurants are returning and there will be a lot more food. There will be music on the inside within the fieldhouse. Easter Seals will be the organization that will receive a donation this year. A volunteer request will be circulated with the bulk of the volunteers needed where the kid activities occur. Looking at options for beverage sales based on feedback from attendees.
- **H.** Student Directory Nancy Bennett Development has started. Again, a contest will occur for a student design for the cover. An opt out option available for those who do not want to be included in the directory. The form is located on the Novi Community Schools website.
- I. Spirit wear Budget proposal- Tricia Hankerson & Sheri VanKirk request for budget of \$2,500 that will be used to purchase spirit wear that will be sold at events and in the Cat Rack. Mr. Armstrong will be providing the manpower used to sell the merchandise from his marketing students.
