- \*Show was a HUGE success- had almost 200 booths filled with crafters, with a waitlist of almost 100 more crafters. It has become one of the best shows in the metro area!!
- \*Over 2,000 people came to the show to shop, including paid shoppers, volunteers and crafters.

- -Booth Fees \$20,215.00 (195 filled booths)
- -Sponsorships \$2,050.00 (6 sponsors)
- -Admissions \$9,280.00 (1,856 paid shoppers, plus crafters & volunteers)
- -Raffle \$1,421.00
- -Concessions \$258.00
- -Food Trucks \$400

Total Income: \$33,624.00 (still collecting from one of the sponsors)

Expenses: Yard signs, postcards, advertising, hospitality, goodie bags, concessions, printing. T-shirts, other miscellaneous costs (still collecting receipts) Between \$3,000.00 & \$3,500.00.

- \*NOVI ATHLETIC BOOSTERS' SCHOLARSHIP The purpose of the Novi High School Athletic Boosters' Scholarship is to recognize 4 student-athletes, 2 females and 2 males, who have demonstrated their ability to achieve success at academics, athletics, and school/community involvement during their high school years. Minimum requirements are participation in one or more varsity sports for a minimum of 2 years, one of which must be senior year. Also required is participation in additional school/community activity or volunteer work. You must write a 1-2 page, 1.5 spaced essay describing a time of personal adversity during your playing career. How did being a part of a team/individual sport help you manage, or conquer it, and what you learned from it.
